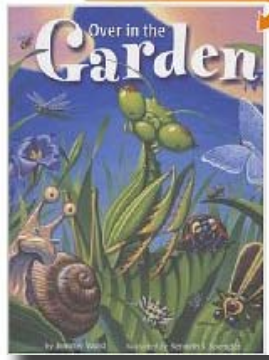


Mark Your Calendar
